CCB TALENTED TEEN RULES & REGULATIONS

1. A contestant must be 13 to 17 years of age at the time of entry, but must not be 18 years old before July 2007 and must furnish a notarized copy of birth certificate at time of entry.
2. A contestant must be an Anguillian or a resident of Anguilla for more than 90 days prior to August 2007.
3. A contestant must be single, never divorced or had a marriage annulled, or have children, or expectant.
4. A contestant must have or maintain a good school attendance with passing grades and a good character. Last report card or transcript must be submitted.
5. A contestant must have a youthful, teenage appearance and be in good health.
6. A contestant must furnish all garments required for participation in the CCB Talented Teen as outlined in the following competition segments. All garments must be in good taste as determined by CCB Trendsetters.
7. NO BATHING SUITS ALLOWED IN ANY CONTEST.
8. There is a minimum of a \$100 scholarship per contestant which is set for prizes.
9. CCB Trendsetters officials sponsors are responsible for providing the winners of such contests with round trip transportation and accommodations, meals and incidentals, as well as an adult chaperone of their choice for participation in regional or international contests sanctioned by the CCB Trendsetters. Parents are only responsible for out-of-pocket expenses.
10. A contestant should participate in all CCB Talented Teen activities.
11. At the time of entry, a contestant must not be signed to any management contract, nor enter into such contract while participating in a contest, and must not enter into or hold a title to any other contest.
12. If the contestant whose name appears on this application is declared the Winner or 1st Runner Up in the CCB Talented Teen, he or she agrees not to sign any contractual agreement with anyone and will not give written, verbal or photographic endorsement of any mercantile or commercial organization for the year of her reign, without the written and expressed permission of CCB Trendsetters.
13. No CCB Talented Teen winner shall use the contest title without the written and expressed permission of the CCB Trendsetters.

16. If the contestant whose name appears on this application is declared the CCB Talented Teen Pageant Winner or 1st Runner Up, it is agreed that a chaperone of the choice of CCB Trendsetters shall accompany the Winner when fulfilling her commitments. If the Winner is off island, the Winner's parents or legal guardians agree to furnish transportation back to Anguilla.

COMPETITION AND SCORING FOR PAGEANT SHOULD BE AS FOLLOWS:

19. PROMOTIONAL SPEECH APPEARANCE: a 3-minute advertorial speech on a product or service offered by CCB.
ATTIRE: Suitable to performance chosen. 50 POINTS
20. PERFORMING TALENT: Contestants' ability to illustrate their talents, imagination and performance. Singing, dancing, recitations or dramatic readings in good taste is acceptable. Modeling is not acceptable. ATTIRE: Material performed shall be in good taste (beware of mature or offensive song lyrics) and cannot exceed 5 minutes and 30 seconds. Fire acts are not allowed. Instruments and any labor charges connected with transporting such instruments shall be the responsibility of the contestant. Contestants are responsible for providing talent props, musical instruments and any equipment necessary to perform their talent. 65 POINTS
21. BEST EVENING WEAR PERFORMANCE: ATTIRE: Gowns should have a youthful appearance and should be ankle length or to the floor. Backless, strapless, low-cut and short dresses are not allowed; shoes (heels no higher than 2 inches). Suits should reflect sophistication, simplicity and individuality and should be tailored to fit neatly. Contestants will also be judged on their ability to model, deportment, poise and stage presence. 30 POINTS
22. ON STAGE INTERVIEW PERFORMANCE: The ability to answer intelligently in a Formal Setting. 45 POINTS
23. Appropriate under garments shall be worn with all attire.
24. A contestant who has been crowned as a CCB Talented Teen winner cannot re-enter any CCB Talented Teen again, nor can a member of the immediate family of a CCB Trendsetter official enter this contest due to conflicting interests and ensuing difficulties. If there is an entrant, the contestant will be disqualified and loses all rights under the existing contract.
